

Work Proposal 2026

Rule of 3 proposal to get all racing members helping out with our club

This proposal is aimed at all our racing members to ensure everyone plays their part and pulls their weight with preparing for and running race days. There is more to do than many realise and it is unfair that it falls to the same few every year.

My proposal allows members to help out when it fits in best for them, but all must help out over the season on at least 3 occasions.

Proposal

All racing members must help at the club on minimum of 3 occasions, for the full day, or duration of the event (work party).

Only 1 of the 3 occasions will be counted from a non-race meeting work party. The other 2 must be completed on racing weekends.

On a race weekend we would like members to do either 4 half days or 2 full days.

The Committee members will be responsible for each work party/race weekend to allocate tasks and note down who has helped.

If all 3 days haven't been completed your top 3 points scores from the club racing season will be removed from your final season points tally.

You can check at race control each meeting to see how you are doing on this.

Age bands:

Anyone under 12 is exempt,

Anyone 12-14 is exempt from work party days, but are required to help out at least 2 days on racing weekends

Anyone 14-15 is preferred to attend a work party to learn but not compulsory and must complete 2 days on racing weekends

Ruling then applies to every racing member from 16 plus

Exemptions:

Other sporting or work commitments are acceptable as a reason for being unable to attend work parties, but this must be notified to the committee ahead of the work party dates, and 3 days would then be required at race weekends.

Medical issues – again must notify committee

NB, this is aimed at racing members only, although we of course would encourage all members to help out at your club whenever possible.
